Renew Opelika Road Phase 4 - Gentry Dr to Saugahatchee Rd	Widening Opelika Road from Gentry Drive to Saugahatchee Road to create new grassed median, bicycle lanes and left-turn lanes.	\$	1,375,265.00
Cox Road Reconstruction & Widening - Wire Rd to Tech Park	Widening Cox Road from Wire Rd to Fieldview Dr to accommodate two, six-foot wide bicycle lanes.	\$	1,599,250.00
N College Street/E University Drive/Shug Jordan Parkway Intersection Improvements	Widening Shug Jordan Parkway to accommodate a southbound left turn lane, widening E University Drive to accommodate a northbound right turn and installation of a new traffic signal at N College Street.	\$	300,000.00
Richland Road Connector - Hwy 14/Webster Rd - Design	Engineering design services for a new roadway extending Webster Rd, approximately 7850 linear feet, consisting of two or three lanes with additional turn lanes at Richland Rd and Hwy 14.	\$	300,000.00
Ogletree Road Culvert Replacement	Replacement of an undersized culvert on Ogletree Rd at Moores Mill Creek with a larger and wider culvert to accommodate future roadway widening and sidewalk.	\$	350,000.00
